

## Traffic snapshot

- Total MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) recorded 11.1million passenger movements in January 2019, a 3.1% growth over the same corresponding period last year.
- International sector registered a 2.5% growth with 5.4million passenger movements in January 2019, while domestic sector grew by 3.6% registering 5.7million passengers.
- On a twelve-month basis, the MAHB network of airports grew 3.7%, registering 133.5million passenger movements, the highest passenger movements to-date.
- Malaysia passenger movements grew by 3.2% for January 2019 registering 8.4million passengers. Domestic and international passenger movements grew by 7.1% and 0.004% to 3.9million and 4.4million passengers respectively.
- Istanbul SGIA recorded 2.8million passenger movements, a growth of 2.6% in January 2019. International passenger movements grew by 15.4% with 1.0million passengers, while domestic passenger movements declined by 3.2% with 1.8million passengers.

## Traffic performance for Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad's (MAHB) network of airports

MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) recorded 11.1million passengers in January 2019, 3.1% above January 2018. International sector recorded 5.4million passengers with a year-on-year increase of 2.5% while the domestic sector recorded 5.7million passengers with 3.6% growth compared to the same period last year. On a last-twelve-month basis, the total MAHB network registered 3.7% growth with 133.5million passengers. Overall aircraft movements decreased by 0.5% in January. International and domestic aircraft movements decreased by 0.7% and 0.3% respectively over January 2018.

On the local front, airports in Malaysia registered 8.4million passenger movements in January 2019, a 3.2% y-o-y growth over January 2018. International sector registered 4.4million passengers, with a growth of 0.004% over January 2018, while domestic sector recorded 3.9million passengers with 7.1% growth. International passenger movements for non-ASEAN countries grew by 0.7% to 2.3million passengers whereas ASEAN passenger movements declined by 0.8% to 2.1million passengers. Overall aircraft movements declined by 1.8%. Domestic aircraft movements recorded 0.3% growth while the international sector declined by 4.8%. Overall average load factor was 72.9% in January 2019, an increase of 0.6 percentage points over January 2018.

KLIA handled 5.1million passengers in January 2019, 0.1% above January 2018. Domestic passenger movements increased by 5.0% while international passenger movements declined by 1.5%. ASEAN and non-ASEAN passengers decreased by 2.1% and 1.1% respectively. Passenger movements at KLIA Main increased by 0.3% y-o-y with 2.3million while passenger movements at klia2 declined by 0.1% with 2.8million passengers. The last-twelve-month passenger movements for KLIA Main recorded 28.1million passenger movements, a decline of 0.4% over January 2019 while klia2 recorded 31.9million passenger movements, an increase of 4.3% over the corresponding period in 2018. Overall aircraft movements at KLIA decreased by 3.5% year-on-year in January 2019. International aircraft movements declined by 5.4% while the domestic aircraft movements increased by 0.8%.

MASB Airports handled 3.3million passengers, an increase of 8.4% in January 2019. International and domestic passenger movements increased by 9.3% and 8.2% respectively. The international passenger movements was mainly driven by non-ASEAN sector with a growth of 13.8%.

Istanbul SGIA passenger movements grew by 2.6% year-on-year in January 2019. International passenger movements increased by 15.4% while the domestic passenger movements declined by

3.2%. Total aircraft movements increased by 5.1% for the same period with international aircraft

movements increasing by 19.4% while domestic sector declining by 2.6%.

Overview of traffic

The 11.1million passenger movements in January 2019 is above the general norm for MAHB's

network of airports, considering January is generally a low travelling month. Such performance was

only recorded during the peak season months in 2018. On the local front, Malaysia's passenger

movements is undergoing some corrections for domestic growth as originally expected. Despite the

cut in international frequencies and temporary suspension of operation by Firefly and Indonesia

AirAsia X, new airlines and new routes were also introduced from the fourth quarter of 2018 which

carried the growth momentum in to January 2019. The improvement in the average load factor for

both domestic and international sectors by 1.1 and 0.4 percentage points to 69.7% and 76.0%

respectively is encouraging.

Central Asia, North America, North East Asia and the South West Pacific sectors registered growth

in passenger movements. Kota Kinabalu, Kuching, Langkawi, and Ipoh recorded double-digit growth

for international passengers. Meanwhile, Shenzhen Airlines, Indonesia AirAsia, Air Seoul, Xiamen

Airlines, China Southern Airlines and Royal Brunei Airlines were among the airlines that recorded

double-digit growth in January 2019.

Istanbul SGIA's international passenger traffic growth momentum has continued from last year and

this positive trend is expected to continue.
