

Traffic snapshot

- Total MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) registered 0.5% growth for October 2018 over October 2017 with 10.7million passenger movements.
- International passenger movements registered a 2.2% growth with 5.1million passengers in October 2018, while domestic passenger movements decreased by 1.0% with 5.6million movements.
- On a twelve-month basis, the MAHB network of airports registered 132.3million passenger movements.
- Malaysia passengers declined by 1.3% in October 2018 registering 7.8million movements.
 International and domestic passenger movements declined by 0.8% and 1.8% respectively.
- Istanbul SGIA passenger movements registered 2.9million passengers, recording a growth of 5.6% over the same month in 2017. International passenger movements recorded a double-digit 15.5% increase while domestic passenger movements increased by 0.7%.

Traffic performance at Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad's (MAHB) network of airports

MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) recorded 10.7million passenger movements in October 2018, a 0.5% growth over October 2017. International traffic recorded 5.1million passenger movements with a year-on-year increase of 2.2% while domestic passenger movements decreased by 1.0% recording 5.6million passenger movements compared to October 2017. On a last-twelve-month basis, the total MAHB network of airports registered 4.4% growth with 132.3million passengers, the highest volume passengers handled to-date that was also recorded in September 2018. Overall aircraft movements increased by 4.1% with international and domestic aircraft movements recording an increase of 3.3% and 4.6% respectively over October 2017.

On the local front, airports in Malaysia registered a 1.3% decline year-on-year over October 2017 with 7.8million passenger movements. International sector recorded 4.0million passenger movements with a decline of 0.8% while domestic sector recorded 1.8% decline with 3.8million passengers. International traffic for ASEAN destinations grew 0.1% to 2.0million passenger movements whereas non-ASEAN passenger movements declined by 1.7% to 2.0million passengers. Overall aircraft movements increased by 3.3%. International and domestic aircraft movements increased by 1.3% and 4.7% respectively. Overall average load factor was 67.7% in October 2018, a decline of 5.7 percentage points over October 2017.

KLIA passenger movements registered 4.7million passengers in October 2018, a decline of 2.3% over October 2017. International passenger movements declined by 2.7% while domestic passenger movements decreased by 1.5% over October 2017. KLIA Main Terminal and klia2 passengers declined by 1.4% and 3.1% respectively. The last-twelve-month passenger movements for KLIA Main Terminal recorded 28.1million passengers, a decline of 0.5% while klia2 increased by 6.9% with 31.7million passenger movements over the same period last year. Overall aircraft movements at KLIA increased by 1.1% over the same month last year. Domestic aircraft movements at KLIA registered an increase of 8.4% while international aircraft movements declined by 1.9%.

Passenger movements at MASB Airports registered an increase of 0.3% year-on-year over October 2017 with 3.1million passenger movements. International passenger movements increased by 10.1% recording 0.6million passengers. Domestic passenger movements decreased by 2.0% with 2.5million passengers. ASEAN traffic increased by 10.1% with 0.4million passengers while non-ASEAN traffic registered a growth of 10.3% with 0.2million passengers. Domestic passenger movements decreased by 2.0% to 2.5million passengers in October 2018. Aircraft movements in October 2018 increased by 5.2%. International and domestic aircraft movements increased by 15.1% and 3.6% respectively.

Istanbul SGIA passenger traffic registered a growth of 5.6% growth in October 2018 over the same period in 2017 with 2.9million passengers. International passenger movements increased by 15.5% to 1.1million passengers while domestic passenger movements grew by 0.7% to 1.9million passengers. Total aircraft movements increased by 7.0%, with both international and domestic aircraft movements recording an increase of 12.1% and 4.1% respectively.

Overview of traffic

The latent demand for air travel at airports in Malaysia has shown some weakness from September 2018. This is increasingly evident from the declining load factors experienced in both domestic and international sectors. The overall performance of passenger movements at Malaysia airports was also partly affected by airlines route restructuring with airlines offering more direct international connectivity from MASB airports, by-passing KLIA.

Despite the lower passenger movements in October 2018, there was a double-digit passenger growth in sectors such as Adelaide, Bangalore, Bangkok, Batam, Brisbane, Cam Ranh, Chengdu, Fuzhou, Guiyang, Honolulu, Jeddah, Kunming, Lahore, Muscat, Nanjing, Phnom Penh, Amman, Amritsar, Riyadh, Narita and Xi'an. North East Asia, North America and Middle East registered positive passenger movements in October 2018 over October 2017.

13 airlines registered double-digit growth in October 2018 for international passenger movements. This includes Air Mauritius, Air China, Biman Bangladesh, China Southern, Indonesia AirAsia, Iraqi Airways, Lucky Air, Nepal Airlines, Saudi Arabian, Shanghai Airlines, Shenzhen Airlines, Tiger Airways, Uzbekistan Airlines and Xiamen Airlines.

Istanbul SGIA continued to register double-digit growth for the international sector in October 2018. Pobeda Airlines has added another route and has begun daily flights to and from St. Petersburg in October 2018. Turkish Airlines has commenced three weekly flight to Doha from 30 October 2018.

There are some challenges for the usual growth momentum. The increase in oil prices may affect airlines and ultimately passenger traffic in the medium and long-term. The uncertainty surrounding US-China trade tension, IMF's downward revision of GDP and Malaysia's own lower GDP are challenging factors for air travel.
