

## Traffic snapshot

- Total MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) registered 3.8% growth for November 2018 over November 2017 with 11.0million passenger movements.
- International passenger movements registered a 5.8% growth with 5.2million passengers in November 2018 while domestic passenger movements increased by 2.0% with 5.7million movements.
- On a twelve-month basis, the MAHB network of airports registered 132.8million passenger movements, the highest passenger movements to-date.
- Malaysia passenger movements recorded a growth of 4.3% registering 8.3million passengers in November 2018 over November 2017. International and domestic passenger movements grew by 4.0% and 4.6% respectively.
- Istanbul SGIA passenger movements registered 2.6million passengers, recording a growth of 2.3% over the same month in 2017. International passenger movements recorded a 15.4% increase while domestic passenger movements decreased by 3.7%.

## Traffic performance at Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad's (MAHB) network of airports

MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) recorded 11.0million passenger movements in November 2018, a 3.8% growth over November 2017. International passenger movements recorded 5.2million passengers with a year-on-year increase of 5.8% while domestic passenger movements increased by 2.0% recording 5.7million passengers compared to November 2017. On a last-twelvementh basis, the total MAHB network of airports registered 4.2% growth with 132.8million passenger movements, the highest volume of passengers handled to-date. Overall aircraft movements increased by 5.3% with international and domestic aircraft movements recording an increase of 6.1% and 4.8% respectively over November 2017.

On the local front, airports in Malaysia registered a 4.3% growth over November 2017 with 8.3million passenger movements. International sector recorded 4.3million passenger movements with a growth of 4.0% while domestic sector recorded 4.6% growth with 4.0million passengers. The 4.6% growth for domestic sector is the second highest for the year. ASEAN destinations international traffic grew by 3.6% while the non-ASEAN passenger movements grew by a higher 4.3%. Overall aircraft movements increased by 5.1%. International and domestic aircraft movements increased by 4.0% and 5.9% respectively. Overall average load factor was 74.4% in November 2018, 1.4 percentage points less than November 2017.

KLIA passenger movements registered 5.0million passengers in November 2018, a growth of 3.3% over November 2017. International and domestic passenger movements grew by 2.7% and 4.9% over November 2017. KLIA Main Terminal and klia2 passenger movements increased by 2.1% and 4.4% respectively. The last-twelve-month passenger movements for KLIA Main Terminal recorded 28.2million passengers, a 0.5% decline, while klia2 increased by 6.2% with 31.8million passenger movements over the same period last year. Overall aircraft movements at KLIA increased by 3.9% over the same month last year. International and domestic aircraft movements at KLIA registered an increase of 0.9% and 10.9% respectively.

Passenger movements at MASB Airports registered an increase of 5.8% year-on-year over November 2017 with 3.3million passenger movements. International passenger movements increased by 11.3% recording 0.7million passengers. Domestic passenger movements increased by 4.6% with 2.6million passengers. ASEAN traffic increased by 10.6% with 0.4million passengers while non-ASEAN traffic registered a growth of 12.4% with 0.3million passengers. Aircraft movements in November 2018 increased by 6.2%. International and domestic aircraft movements increased by 17.0% and 4.4% respectively.

Istanbul SGIA passenger traffic registered a growth of 2.3% growth in November 2018 over the same period in 2017 with 2.6million passengers. International passenger movements increased by 15.4% to 1.0million passengers while domestic passenger movements declined by 3.7% to 1.7million passengers. The decline in domestic sector was due to Sunexpress cancelling Izmir's daily route and Pegasus decreasing aircraft utilisation for domestic routes. Total aircraft movements increased by 6.1%, with both international and domestic aircraft movements recording an increase of 16.0% and 0.8% respectively.

## Overview of traffic

The 3.8% passenger movements growth for MAHB network of airports was driven by airlines launch of new routes for both international and domestic sector, additional frequencies and operation of new airlines, in particular at Malaysia Airports network of airports. Indigo Airlines, a low-cost airline based in India and Condor Airlines, a leisure airline based in Frankfurt, Germany commenced operation to klia2 and KLIA Main in November.

Malaysia passenger movements traffic performance was driven by both the international and domestic sectors. The international sector registered an encouraging average load factor of 77.8% for November 2018, an increase of 1.7 percentage points over November 2017. Many city pairs registered high growth over November last year. The sectors that registered more than 20% growth include Adelaide, Almaty, Bangalore, Brisbane, Cam Ranh, Changsha, Denpasar, Hangzhou, Hat Yai, Lahore, Macau, Melbourne, Muscat, Nanjing, Padang, Palembang, Qingdao, Seoul, Shanghai, Sihanouk, Taipei, Tashkent, Haneda, Vishakhapatnam, Xi'an, Xiamen and Yinchuan. Middle East, South East Asia, North East Asia and South West Pacific registered positive passenger movements for November 2018. There was an improvement in domestic average load factor for November 2018 compared to September and October 2018, but the overall domestic sector average load factor continues to remain in the negative territory over 2017. There is more focus on international routes over domestic routes at Istanbul SGIA.
