

Traffic Snapshot

- In November 2024, the MAHB network of airports registered 11.2million total passenger movements, recording a double-digit growth of 16.1% over November 2023 and trending close to pre-pandemic levels at 96.7%.
- International passenger movements continued to display resilience, reaching 54% of traffic share exceeding pre-pandemic traffic share of 48% and recording 9.1% growth over pre-pandemic levels with 6.0million passengers.
- Domestic passenger movements recorded 5.1million passengers, an increase of 10.0% over November 2023.
- Airports in Malaysia handled by MAHB recorded a total of 7.7million passenger movements, an increase of 15.8% over November 2023, reaching 88.7% of pre-pandemic levels.
- International and domestic passenger movements registered 4.1million and 3.6million passengers, reaching 93.9% and 83.4% respectively over November 2019.
- Istanbul SGIA continues to thrive recording double-digit growth of 16.6% in traditionally a low month with 3.5million passenger movements in November 2024, representing a credible 20.7% increase over pre-pandemic levels.
- The international sector has been the main driver of growth, recording an impressive double-digit growth of 68.2% over pre-pandemic levels, with 1.9million passengers. Domestic passenger movements showed steady performance, registering 1.6million passengers.

Overview of traffic

November 2024 passenger movements were unprecedented with passenger movements recording credible double-digit growth over the same corresponding month for both Malaysia and Turkey operations in a conventionally low season. Total passenger movements recorded 11.2million passengers, trending close to pre-pandemic level at 96.7%. The international sector's robust traffic continues to drive growth, recording 6.0million passengers, a 21.8% increase over November 2023 and exceeding pre-pandemic levels by 9.1%. The strong traffic momentum was supported by new airline operations, the introduction of 5 new routes and 42 additional weekly frequencies. The domestic sector was equally buoyant, recording 5.1million passenger movements, a double-digit growth over November 2023, reaching 85.4% of pre-pandemic 2019 levels.

On the local front, Malaysia Airports passenger movements continue to grow handling 7.7million passengers, a 15.8% increase over November 2023. The international sector was resilient, recording 4.1million passengers, driven by new airline operations and the commencement of new routes. AirAsia launched Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) to Da Lat (four weekly flights), to Chiang Rai (three weekly flights), and to Port Blair (three weekly flights), as well as from Kota Kinabalu International Airport to Kaohsiung (four weekly flights). AirAsia X introduced a new route

connecting Kuala Lumpur International Airport to Nairobi with four weekly flights. VietJet Air began daily flights from Kuala Lumpur International Airport to Hanoi, Batik Air added ten weekly flights from KLIA to Bintulu, and Hong Kong Express launched daily flights from Penang International Airport to Hong Kong. Turkish Airlines commenced the longest route to Sydney from Turkey through KLIA with four weekly flights.

Domestic movements in November 2024 recorded 3.6million passengers, reaching 83.4% of prepandemic levels. The average load factor for November 2024 was 78.8%, a 5.4 percentage point with airlines seat capacity at 82.9% over pre-pandemic levels. These encouraging dynamics in air travel reflect an optimistic demand that would support a positive traffic trajectory for recovery.

In November 2024, Istanbul SGIA recorded 3.5million passengers continue to be driven by the international sector as airlines continue to expand to new routes and adding frequencies, marking a 16.6% growth over November 2023 and surpassing 2019 levels by 20.7%. International and domestic passenger movements at both sectors were robust, sustaining high average load factors above 80% with 1.9million and 1.6million passengers, reflecting an increase of 24.3% and 8.6% over November 2023, respectively.
