

Traffic snapshot

- The decline in traffic performance seen in the last week of January 2020 continued and heightened in the month of February 2020 as expected in the wake of the Covid-19 outbreak.
- Total MAHB System registered a decline of 16.7% with 8.9million passenger movements.
- International and domestic sector declined by 21.3% and 12.5% with 4.0million and 4.9million passenger movements respectively.
- On a last trailing twelve-month basis, total MAHB system recorded a 4.3% growth with 140.2million passenger movements.
- Malaysia overall passenger movements registered 6.2million passengers, a decline of 23.4% over February 2019.
- International and domestic sector declined by 29.6% and 16.8% with 2.9million and 3.3million passenger movements respectively.
- Istanbul SGIA recorded 2.6million passenger movements, a growth of 4.9% in February 2020. International passenger movements grew by 16.6% with 1.1million passengers, while domestic passenger movements continued to decline by 1.9% with 1.6million passengers.

Traffic performance of Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad's (MAHB) network of airports

MAHB network of airports recorded 8.9million passengers in February 2020, a decline of 16.7% over February 2019. International and domestic sector registered 4.0million and 4.9million passenger movements with a decline of 21.3% and 12.6% respectively over the same period last year. On a last trailing twelve-month basis, the total MAHB network (inclusive of Istanbul SGIA) registered 4.3% growth with 140.2million passenger movements. Overall aircraft movements increased by 1.1% over February 2019. International aircraft movements declined by 1.7% while domestic aircraft movements increased by 3.0% over February 2019.

On the local front, airports in Malaysia registered 6.2million passenger movements in February 2020, a decline of 23.4% over the same period last year. International and domestic sector recorded 2.9million and 3.3million passenger movements a decline of 29.6% and 16.8% respectively over the same corresponding period last year. ASEAN and non-ASEAN passenger movements declined by 26.2% and 32.9% with 1.5million and 1.4million passenger movements. Overall aircraft movements increased by 0.2%. Domestic aircraft movements grew by 3.7% while

international aircraft movements declined by 5.2%. Overall average load factor was 59.2%, a decline of 17.2 percentage points over February 2019.

KLIA passenger movements declined by 24.2% in February 2020 registering 3.6million passenger movements over February 2019. ASEAN and non-ASEAN sectors declined by 24.6% and 26.6% over the same period last year. Domestic sector declined by 20.5% with 1.1million passengers. Passenger movements at KLIA Main Terminal and klia2 decreased by 20.2% and 27.2% respectively. The last trailing twelve-month passenger movements for KLIA Main recorded 28.9million passengers while klia2 recorded 32.5million passengers. Overall aircraft movements at KLIA decreased by 2.8% over February last year. International and domestic aircraft movements at KLIA declined by 3.6% and 1.0% respectively.

MASB airports declined by 22.2% over February 2018 with 2.6million passenger movements in February 2020. International and domestic passenger movements declined by 49.0% and 15.0% respectively over February 2019.

Istanbul SGIA passenger traffic grew by 4.9% in February 2020. International passenger movements increased by 16.6% while the domestic passenger movements declined by 1.9%.

Overview of traffic

February 2020 passenger performance was affected by the impact of Covid-19 outbreak. The impact in passenger traffic was felt as soon as China imposed a lockdown in several of the country's provinces and the World Health Organisation declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern. This led to airlines announcing temporary flight suspensions, flight cancellations and travel restrictions imposed by certain countries.

For the international sector, there was a reduction of 1,380 flight movements compared to February 2019. On a weekly basis, 2,935 less flight movements for both the international and domestic sector were recorded in the last week of February 2020 compared over January 2020. A similar scenario was observed during the Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS) outbreak in 2003 where there was a sharp decline in traffic on the first month of impact which continued to peak for the following 2 months. The decline in traffic due to the SARS outbreak continued for several months and eventually picked up when the decline in infected cases reduced and travel confidence resumed.

Towards the end of February 2020, there was a contraction in the overall average load factor to 59.2%. Despite the outbreak, airlines are trying to fill up seats by offering attractive low fare

packages to attract travellers. The Malaysian Government has also announced several initiatives to spur traffic under the 2020 Economic Stimulus Package.

Most of the regions registered double-digit decline in passenger movements except for the Middle East and South Asia regions, which registered a marginal growth for February 2020. Twelve (12) airlines registered growth for international passenger movements with seven (7) of the airlines registering double-digit growth for February 2020.

Istanbul SGIA passenger movements continued to register an encouraging growth for the international sector by 16.6% for February 2020.
