

Traffic snapshot

- Total MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) registered 3.7% growth for Q1 2019 with 33.4million passenger movements.
- International sector registered a 3.4% growth with 16.1million passenger movements in Q1 2019, while domestic sector increased by 4.0% with 17.4million passengers.
- On a twelve-month basis, the total MAHB network of airports registered 134.4million passenger movements an increase of 3.3%, the highest recorded for the network to-date.
- Malaysia passenger movements registered a 3.9% growth while Istanbul SGIA registered a 3.3% increase over Q1 2018.
- March 2019 passenger movements system-wide registered 3.1% growth with 11.7million passengers. International and domestic sector increased by 3.0% and 3.1% respectively.
- Malaysia passenger movements increased by 3.1% in March 2019 with an average load factor of 75.8%. Domestic movements increased by 6.9% while the international sector declined by 0.4%.
- Istanbul SGIA recorded a 3.1% growth with 20.5% growth in international sector and a decline of 5.4% for domestic.

Traffic performance for MAHB's network of airports

MAHB's network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) recorded 11.7million passengers in March 2019, a 3.1% growth over March 2018. International traffic recorded 5.5million passengers with a year-on-year increase of 3.0% while domestic traffic grew by 3.1% recording 6.1million passengers. On a last-twelve-month basis, the total MAHB network (inclusive of Istanbul SGIA) registered 3.3% growth with 134.4million passengers over the previous 12months. Overall aircraft movements increased by 1.1% with international and domestic movements registering an increase of 2.0% and 0.6% respectively over March 2018.

On the local front, airports in Malaysia registered 8.9million passengers in March 2019, a 3.1% year-on-year growth over March 2018. Domestic sector recorded 4.4million passengers with a 6.9% increase while the international sector recorded 4.5million passengers, a decline of 0.4%. International traffic for ASEAN countries grew by 2.1% to 2.2million passengers whereas non-ASEAN traffic decreased by 2.9% to 2.2million passengers. Overall aircraft movements increased by 1.0%. International aircraft movements declined by 1.2% while domestic movements increased by 2.5% over March 2018. Average load factor for overall traffic declined by 1.0 percentage points to 75.8 in March 2019 over March 2018.

KLIA passenger movements recorded a 0.04% increase in March 2019 registering 5.2million passenger movements over March 2018. The international sector declined by 0.7% with 3.8million passengers. A total of 1.8million passengers was recorded for ASEAN sector with 2.3% growth while 1.9million passengers were recorded for non-ASEAN, a decline of 3.4%. Domestic sector passenger movements increased by 2.0% over March 2018 with 1.5million passengers. March 2019 passenger movements for KLIA Main Terminal declined by 0.6% while klia2 increased by 0.6%. The last-twelve-months passenger movements for KLIA Main Terminal recorded 28.2million passengers while klia2 handled 32.0million passengers. Overall aircraft movements at KLIA increased by 1.0% over the same month last year. International aircraft movements at KLIA declined by 0.4% while domestic aircraft movements increased by 4.1%.

Passenger movements for MASB Airports grew by 7.7% year-on-year over March 2018 with 3.6million passengers in March 2019. International passenger movements grew by 1.0% with 0.7million movements. ASEAN traffic grew by 1.2% in March 2019 while non-ASEAN traffic increased by 0.6%.

Istanbul SGIA passenger movements increased by 3.1% to 2.8million in March 2019. International sector recorded a growth of 20.5% while the domestic sector declined by 5.4% over March 2018.

Over the last twelve months, total passengers grew by 5.5% with 34.3million movements. International passenger traffic increased by 13.3% while domestic grew by 1.7%.

First Quarter Traffic

MAHB's network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) recorded 33.4million passenger movements in Q1 2019 representing a growth of 3.7% over Q1 2018. International traffic registered 3.4% growth with 16.1million passengers while domestic passenger movements increased by 4.0% with 17.4million passengers. Total aircraft movements increased by 1.1% while the international and domestic aircraft movements increased by 1.4% and 1.0% respectively over the same period in 2018.

Airports in Malaysia registered a 3.9% growth with 25.4million passenger movements. International traffic and domestic traffic increased by 0.6% and 7.7% respectively. Aircraft movements grew by 0.7% in Q1 2019 over Q1 2018. International movements declined by 2.1% while domestic sector increased by 2.5% over Q1 2018.

KLIA passenger movements grew by 1.0% with 15.1million passengers in Q1 2019. International traffic registered 11.0million passengers a decline of 0.3% over Q1 2018. ASEAN sector increased by 1.7% while non-ASEAN sector declined by 2.1%. Domestic sector increased by 4.7%. KLIA Main Terminal passenger movements increased by 0.9%. International sector declined by 0.1% to 5.7million movements. ASEAN traffic declined by 0.03% to 2.1million while non-ASEAN declined by 0.2% with 3.5million movements. Domestic traffic at KLIA Main increased by 5.8% over Q1 2018. Passenger movements at klia2 grew by 1.0% with 8.2million passengers. International traffic declined by 0.6% while domestic traffic increased by 4.2% over Q1 2018.

Total passenger movements at Istanbul SGIA increased by 3.3% with 8.1million passengers over Q1 2018. International traffic increased by 18.5% while domestic sector declined by 3.8% over Q1 2018.

Overview of traffic

The overall passenger movement of 3.7% growth for the network of airport in Q1 2019 was driven by both international and domestic sector albeit with a different traffic backdrop for Malaysia and Istanbul SGIA.

Malaysia's Q1 2019 growth was driven by the domestic sector, partly due to higher seat capacity offered by airlines to match air travel demand. International passenger volume remains above the average high base traffic achieved in 2H 2018 although there are some signs of adjustments partly due to aircraft utilisation, exit and entry in airlines operations on parallel routes and the temporary suspension of Firefly's operation to Seletar, Singapore. Three international carriers which operated

B737MAX to KLIA had switched to other aircraft type after the Ethiopian Air incident. The Indonesian carriers were seen to reduce flight frequencies after the Lion Air crash in October 2018 which is also related to B737MAX. The recent grounding of the B737MAX may have further negative impact on Indonesian carriers' capacity to Malaysia. However, the impact from this may not be significant as most of the Indonesia sectors have competing operators.

Fifteen domestic airports registered growth in Q1 2019. Airports that recorded a double-digit growth were Kota Kinabalu, Kuching, Melaka, Ipoh, Kuantan, Tawau, Labuan, Bintulu and Sibu. Central Asia, North America, North East Asia, Europe and South East Asia sectors registered growth over Q1 2018.

Istanbul SGIA's traffic was essentially driven by the international sector as some of the major airlines shifted some of the operations from domestic to international sector. Additionally, several new airlines came into operations in the 2H 2018.

Moving forward, the future seat capacity filings by airlines remain above expectation and MAHB remains cautiously optimistic that the projected 4.9% growth for 2019 would be achievable. The domestic traffic correction and consolidation is expected to continue while the international sector may see some improvement. Istanbul SGIA performance will likely maintain its growth momentum especially for the international passenger traffic.
