

Traffic snapshot

- Total MAHB network of airports registered 2.0million passengers in April 2021 against a low base in April 2020, when the first full lock down was imposed.
- The 2.0million passengers movements registered in April 2021 was achieved despite continued interstate and international border closure in Malaysia, as well as interstate city suspension and temporary border closure to passengers from nine (9) countries in Turkey.
- International and domestic passenger movements registered 548,000 and 1.4million passenger movements in April 2021 respectively.
- The attempt by both Malaysia and Turkey Government to introduce additional and renewed measures to curb the rise in COVID-19 cases and threat of new variant, may lead to a temporary deceleration in passenger recovery. The vaccine rollout planned for the year in Malaysia and Turkey, nevertheless, would mitigate the impact and pave the way for a gradual recovery.

Traffic performance for MAHB's network of airports

MAHB network of airports registered approximately 2.0million passengers in April 2021, a growth of 1366.2% over a low base growth in April 2020. International and domestic passenger movements recorded 548,000 and 1.4million passenger movements respectively. Overall aircraft movements grew by 252.5% with international and domestic aircraft movements increasing by 222.6% and 267.1% respectively over April 2020. On a last-twelve-month basis, the total MAHB network of airports registered 25.2million passengers, a contraction of 79.3% over the same month last year.

On the local front, airports in Malaysia registered 630,000 passenger movements, an increase of 365.5% over April 2020. International and domestic sector recorded 107,000 and 523,000 passengers over April 2020 respectively. Overall aircraft movements increased by 114.9%. International and domestic aircraft movements increased by 67.2% and 138.1% respectively over April 2020.

KLIA recorded 224,000 passenger movements in April 2021 over April 2020. KLIA Main Terminal and klia2 recorded 133,000 and 91,000 passengers. Overall aircraft movements at KLIA increased by 125.6% over April 2020. International and domestic aircraft movements at KLIA increased by 87.9% and 295.4% respectively for the same period. The last-twelve-month passenger traffic for KLIA Main Terminal and klia2 recorded 1.3million and 1.9million passenger movements, a decline of 94.7% and 93.1% respectively over the same corresponding period last year.

Passenger movements at MASB Airports registered 406,000 passenger movements in April 2021. International sector recorded marginal passenger volumes while the domestic sector recorded approximately 403,000 passenger movements. Aircraft movements in April 2021 increased by 114.9%. The international and domestic aircraft movements declined by 18.8% and 125.2% over April 2020.

Total passenger movements at Istanbul SGIA registered 1.4million passenger movements in April 2021. International and domestic sectors registered 441,000 and 913,000 passengers respectively. To-date, Pegasus is operating to 31 domestic and 55 international routes in 33 countries while Anadolujet operates to 25 domestic and 24 international routes in 15 countries in April 2021.

Overview of traffic

Overall April 2021 traffic performance for the network of airports continued to sustain a steady traffic numbers since January 2021 despite being affected by the extended border closure and interstate or intercity suspension at both Malaysia and Turkey, signifying the need and demand for air travel. The challenges to curb the resurgence of COVID-19 cases, however, saw a stricter measure taken by both Government towards the end of April of which travel restrictions would continue to 10 June for Malaysia and 17 May for Turkey. The additional measures, restrictions would add pressure for traffic to recover, that would mitigate however, by the current rate of the vaccination rollout.

There were some pick up on airlines operation with weekly capacity for domestic sector in Malaysia register an increase of 161 weekly flights or 19% growth compared to March 2021, sustaining an average load factor above 57.0%. AirAsia registered the highest average load factor in April of 60%. Indonesia, Singapore, Netherlands, Turkey and United Kingdom recorded an increase in international passenger movements compared to March 2021. As for Istanbul SGIA, in spite of the partial border closure in Turkey, local airlines Pegasus continue to expand, adding Shymkent, Kazakhstan to their network of operation with a weekly flight expected to launch in May 2021.
