

## Traffic snapshot

- Traffic performance at Malaysia and Istanbul SGIA are still affected by the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) in Malaysia and temporary suspension of Istanbul SGIA following the Turkish Government's announcement to close borders.
- Flights for the month of May were still restricted to repatriation and cargo flights.
- The recent announcement on the Recovery Movement Control Order (RMCO) to replace the CMCO from 10 June to 31 August would see more local airlines resume domestic flights. Airlines are working collectively with airports, guided by the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) issued by the Government and guidelines to restart operations by the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO), International Air Transport Association (IATA) and Airport Council International (ACI).
- The Turkish Government has announced relaxation of restrictions that allow intercity travel effective 1 June 2020. Pegasus and Anadolujet Airlines have resumed domestic flights from 1 June and have filed to increase frequencies.
- Total MAHB system passenger movements contracted by 97.8% in May 2020 to 237,000 passengers. International sector registered a 99.3% decline with over 33,000 passenger movements in May 2020, while domestic passenger movements declined by 96.4% to 204,000 passengers.
- On a twelve-month basis, total MAHB system recorded 111.2million passenger movements over the same corresponding period last year.

## Traffic performance for MAHB's network of airports

MAHB network of airports registered approximately 237,000 passengers in May 2020, a decline of 97.8% over May 2019. International and domestic passenger movements recorded 33,000 and 204,000 passengers respectively. On a last-twelve-month basis, the total MAHB network of airports registered 111.2million passengers, a decline of 17.9% over the same period last year. Overall aircraft movements contracted by 88.5% with international and domestic aircraft movements declined by 92.8% and 85.5% respectively over May 2019.

KLIA recorded 88,000 passenger movements with ASEAN and non-ASEAN sector registering 9,000 and 24,000 passenger movements respectively. May 2020 passenger movements for KLIA Main Terminal and klia2 recorded 62,000 and 26,000 passenger movements. The last-twelve-

month passenger movements for KLIA Main Terminal and klia2 recorded 22.9million and 25.1million, a decline of 18.9% and 21.8% respectively over the same corresponding period last year. Overall aircraft movements at KLIA declined by 91.7% over May 2019. International and domestic aircraft movements at KLIA decrease 91.9% and 91.1% respectively.

Passenger movements at MASB Airports declined by 95.4% year-on-year over May 2020 with 149,000 passengers in May 2020. International passenger movements recorded marginal passenger volumes while the domestic sector recorded approximately 148,000 passenger movements. Aircraft movements in May 2020 declined by 80.4%. The international and domestic aircraft movements declined by 88.0% and 78.9% over May 2019.

Istanbul SGIA was temporarily closed for operations in May 2020. However, there were several flights in May with marginal passenger volume due to repatriation of Turkish citizens. Domestic flights have since resumed on 1 June 2020 with limited capacity during the initial restart of operations by local airlines, gradually increasing frequencies over the coming weeks.

## Overview of traffic

Traffic performance in Malaysia and Turkey continued to be affected by the CMCO and temporary suspension of Istanbul ISGA's operations in May 2020. Nevertheless, the restriction of movements at both countries have effectively contained the further spread of pandemic with a fall in COVID-19 new cases towards the end of May. Both the Turkish and Malaysian governments had announced relaxation of restrictions that permitted intercity and interstate travel on 28 May 2020 and 6 June 2020 respectively. International border control restrictions are still in place for Malaysia however, at least until 31 August 2020.

Malaysia Airports has geared up the necessary measures and processes for both travellers and airlines strictly adhering to SOP by Malaysia National Security Council (NACSA) and guidelines by ICAO, IATA and ACI.

The Malaysian Government had also recently announced an additional RM35 billion Short-Term Economic Recovery Plan (ERP) on 5 June 2020, to address the health and economic challenges due to the pandemic. Several of the tax incentives introduced in the recent ERP are expected to support and boost the domestic tourism sector until December 2021.
