

Traffic snapshot

- Total MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) registered a growth of 7.5% for August 2019 over August 2018 with 12.7million passenger movements, the highest passenger volume handled by the network of airports for a single month.
- International and domestic passenger movements registered 7.0% and 7.9% growth with 6.0million and 6.6million passengers respectively.
- On a twelve-month basis, MAHB network of airports recorded 137.5million passenger movements with 4.1% growth, a new record for the network of airports.
- Malaysia passenger movements registered 9.2million passenger movements with 9.2% growth, being the highest growth for the year. International and domestic passenger movements grew by 4.0% and 14.8% respectively.
- Istanbul SGIA registered 3.1% growth in August 2019. International passenger movements grew by 17.5% while domestic passenger movements decreased by 5.4% over August 2018.

Traffic performance for Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad's (MAHB) network of airports

MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) recorded 12.7million passengers in August 2019, a 7.5% growth over August 2018. International passenger movements recorded 6.0million passengers with a year-on-year increase of 7.0% while domestic passenger movements grew by 7.9% recording 6.6million passengers compared to the same period in 2018. On a last-twelve-month basis, the total MAHB network of airports registered 4.1% growth with 137.5million passengers, the highest passengers handled by the network of airports. Overall aircraft movements increased by 4.5%. International and domestic aircraft movements registered an increase of 4.9% and 4.3% respectively over August 2018.

Airports in Malaysia registered 9.2million passenger movements in August 2019, a 9.2% year-on-year growth over August 2018. International and domestic sectors recorded 4.6million and 4.7million passengers with 4.0% and 14.8% growth respectively. International passenger movements for ASEAN and non-ASEAN destinations grew 3.1% and 4.9% to 2.2million and 2.4million passengers respectively. Overall aircraft movements increased by 5.2%. International aircraft movements grew by 1.5% while domestic aircraft movements grew by 7.7% over August 2018. Overall average load factor was 75.3% in August 2019, an increase of 0.3 percentage points over August 2018.

KLIA passenger movements recorded a 6.7% increase over August 2018 with 5.4million passenger movements. ASEAN and non-ASEAN sectors grew by 4.5% and 4.3% respectively over August 2018. Domestic passenger movements registered a high 12.7% growth. August passenger movements for KLIA Main Terminal and klia2 increased by 4.7% and 8.5% respectively. The last-twelve-month passenger movements for KLIA Main Terminal recorded 28.4million passengers an increase of 0.9% while klia2 grew by 3.0% with 32.7million passengers over the same corresponding period last year. Overall aircraft movements at KLIA increased by 3.9% over August 2018. International aircraft movements at KLIA grew by 2.0% while domestic aircraft movements increased by 8.1%.

Passenger movements at MASB Airports increased by 12.9% year-on-year over August 2018 to 3.8million. International passenger movements increased by 2.1% recording 0.7million passengers while domestic passenger movements increased by 15.9% with 3.1million passengers. ASEAN passenger movements declined by 2.8% while non-ASEAN passenger movements grew by 8.5%. Aircraft movements in August 2019 increased by 6.3% over August 2018.

Istanbul SGIA passenger movements posted 3.1% growth in August 2019 over the same period last year with 3.4million passengers. International passengers increased by 17.5% to 1.4million passengers while domestic sector declined by 5.4% with 2.0million passengers. Total aircraft movements increased by 2.1% in August 2019. International aircraft movements increased by 17.1% while domestic aircraft movements declined by 7.1% over August 2018.

Overview of traffic

August 2019 overall 12.7million passenger movements was the highest handled for a month to-date and the 7.5% growth recorded for August was also the highest increase recorded to-date for this year.

Airports in Malaysia recorded 9.2% growth with 9.2million passengers in August 2019 over August 2018. All airports except for STOLs registered growth, with fifteen airports recording double-digit growth for August 2019. Domestic passenger movements recorded a high 4.7million passenger movements surpassing December 2018 peak traffic. Regional pairs that registered growth for August 2019 were South Asia, Southeast Asia, Southwest Pacific, North America, Northeast Asia and Africa Region. Thirteen airlines registered double-digit growth for international passenger traffic, including Air Mauritius, Citilink Garuda Indonesia, Eastar Jet, Indonesia AirAsia, Jeju Air, Jin Air, KLM, Malindo Air, Nepal Airlines, Philippines Airlines, Royal Jordanian, Singapore Airlines and SriLankan Airlines. The domestic passenger movements growth was mainly contributed by Malindo Air and AirAsia. The technical glitch to KLIA's Total Airport Management System (TAMS) for a few days from 21st onwards did cause flight delays as well as inconveniences to airlines, passengers and public but there was hardly any material negative impact on demand for air travel.

Istanbul SGIA achieved buoyant performance in August with the highest ever passenger movements recorded for a month to date.
